- 1) Schedules will be viewable on PowerSchool no later than Monday, August 22nd. - 5) \*\*IMPORTANT—PLEASE READ ALL INFO HERE\*\* All students will be eligible for free meals this year across Washington State. However, we still need families to complete the free/reduced-price lunch application if you may qualify. Qualifying students may also be eligible for other benefits, including free or reduced costs for college applications, free enrollment in College in the High School courses at Delta, and more. Applications may be completed online or on paper. Any Delta student may apply for free/reduced-price meals through Pasco School District, or you may also apply through your home district.
